DECLARATION OF EMERGENCY CITY OF CEDAR KEY, FLORIDA TROPICAL STORM ELSA

Whereas, the Mayor of the City of Cedar Key, Florida, under §2.08.01-.09 of the Laws of Cedar Key and the City's Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan, is designated and empowered to declare that a state of emergency exists within the boundaries of the City and to authorize the exercise the emergency powers as set forth in Fla. Stat. §870.041-§870.047, the Laws of Cedar Key, and the City's Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan; and

Whereas, Governor DeSantis, on July 3, 2021, in anticipation of the severe threat posed by Tropical Storm Elsa, signed Executive Order 21-150, (copy attached as Exhibit A), which order declares a state of emergency in the State of Florida, including Levy County; and

Whereas, at present, Tropical Storm Elsa poses a danger to the community, critical infrastructure and general welfare of the City of Cedar Key;

Therefore, I, Heath M. Davis, as Mayor of the City of Cedar Key, declare a state of emergency for the municipal boundaries of the City of Cedar Key, Florida, effective immediately.
